The macro counts the sum of the values from the three cell ranges of the A column and puts the results to the three cells of the B column. To get macros enabled in all Excel workbooks by default, this is what you need to do: Go to the File tab > Options. On the left-side pane, select Trust Center, and then click Trust Center Settings.... In the Trust Center

dialog box, click Macro Settings on the left, select Enable all macros and click OK.

How to enable and disable macros in Excel

If you assign macros a shortcut key, you can bypass the dialog box and access your macro directly from the keyboard in the same way you use shortcut keys to access other commands in Word. Select File, then choose Options. In the Word Options dialog box, go to the left pane and select Custom Ribbon.

Understanding Macros in Microsoft Word

EXCEL MACRO is a record and playback tool that simply records your Excel steps and the macro will play it back as many times as you want. VBA Macros save time as they automate repetitive tasks. It is a piece of programming code that runs in an Excel environment but you don't need to be a coder to program macros.

How to Save and Restore Macros in Microsoft Office

Macros require "relative" cell addresses, which means you "point" to the cells rather than hardcode the actual (or "absolute") cell address (such as A1, B19, C20, etc.) in the macro.

Use Tools > Macros > Organize Macros > LibreOffice Basic to open the LibreOffice Basic Macro dialog (Figure 1). Click Organizer to open the Basic Macro Organizer dialog (Figure 2) and select the Libraries tab. Set the Location to My Macros & Dialogs, which is the default location. Click New to open the New Library dialog.
